



## **Vendor Booth Rules & Regulations for Wellfleet OysterFest (WOF) October 15-16, 2022 RAIN OR SHINE**

Please review the required rules & regulations for WOF 2022 below. We are excited for your participation and aim to create the most seamless experience for you. - All applications must be in the name of the artisans/raw bar owner/food vendor owner.
- Applicants assume all responsibility of risk for any loss connected to the reservation and / or use of space at the Wellfleet OysterFest. Organizers of WOF and related organizations shall in no way be liable to the applicant (or other person the applicant may employ) for damage to property or any other injury.
- Wellfleet OysterFest will NOT provide electricity, other utilities, or rain protection to Arts & Craft, Non-profit, or Raw Bar booths. The show is rain or shine!
- Wellfleet SPAT (WOF parent organization) has the right to cancel the WOF in the event of an Act of God or other unavoidable circumstance. The right to cancel shall continue during the course of the Fest itself.
- Applicants agree to indemnify and hold Wellfleet SPAT and its agents, employees, officers and members of administration harmless for any injury to person or property, including loss of life associated with or arising from the applicant's participation in the Wellfleet OysterFest and all associated activities.
- Applicants will be assigned a booth space as the show committee chairperson sees fit. **WOF reserves the right to relocate spaces as necessary.** Applicants must be in their designated spaces by the start of the 'Fest or will forfeit their right to a booth space.
- No vehicle of any kind will be permitted or used as part of the booth or display. All vehicles must be away from Baker's Field by a time designated by organizers of WOF.
- Wellfleet OysterFest organizers reserve the right to dismiss any exhibitors/vendors or their agents who have shown to misrepresent merchandise on the application without refund and/or booth fee.
- All vendors must have a MA state sales tax # and collect sales tax with the exception of clothing and food. All must list a social security # if you do not have a sales tax #.
- **Tents must be sufficiently weighted/staked with an equivalent of 40 LBS. per leg in case of high winds. There will be no exception or risk being expelled from the WOF.**
- Please agree to this form by checking "yes" on the Vendor Intake Form. By agreeing with this form, applicant verifies they have understood the terms of this agreement.
